Veteran Dog - 7, 2 Abs

- 1st Watson & Fallon's Newlin Anchor Chief ShCM Nice quality & type. Pleasing apprearance with a nice outline, well put together with clean flowing lines, very fit looking dog. His sound free effortless movement won him this good class & **Res. Best Dog.**
- 2nd Cuthill's Ch. Serenaker Trial By Magic Again of very nice type & quality, lovely for size, good fore & hind angles but slightly longer cast in body but firm. He too moved out very well covering the ground very easily.
- 3rd Brannan's Ch. Ardvreck Caerlaverock Von Dapperdawg.

Puppy Dog - 2, 0Abs

- 1st Wrights's Gempeni Disco Nice quality pup. Good for size & substance, just a baby enjoying his day but needs training now. He has a nice front & rear & good body. He can move out but his head will have to come off the ground to show his nice outline. **B.P.D.**
- 2nd English's Gempeni Paso Litter brother to 1, stronger in head & in a larger mould & slightly longer cast than his brother. Again adequate fore & hind angles & things to like about him. Needs training to show himself off to vantage.

1st - English's - Gempeni Paso

Post Grad. Dog - 2, 1Abs

1st – Sneddon's – Dialynne Sirius At Hardexspen – Nice head & exp. Good quality male of nice size & substance. Nicely put together throughout with a balanced look to him showing clean cut lines, he moved out soundly & well in all directions & with ease in profile.

Limit Dog - 6, 1abs.

- 1st Brannan's Rosanka Nolte J.W Nice pleasing head & exp. Good front & rear angles, perhaps a little long cast but firm in topline. Lots to like about him. His movement was good away & back & he was excellent in profile movement.
- 2nd Goldberg's Molesend Orlando J.W Maculine head, nicely made throughout casting a nice outline. Stronger dog than 1, very well off for bone & substance. He moved out very well in all directions effortlessly.

Open Dog - 2, 1Abs

1st – Cuthill, Parker & Stevens – Ch. Serenaker Othello. High quaity male of nice size & substance. Very nice head & exp. Has a very balanced look in outline with everything in the right place & nothing overdone. Well constructed front and rear, firm body, he moved out soundly away & back & with ease in profile movement. **Best Dog & Best In Show.**

Veteran Bitch - 4, 1abs

1st – Deans – Barterhound Bouquet for Gempeni J.W & Sh CM – Nice for quality & type. Lovely feminine

head & soft appealing exp. Nice for size & well put together with no exaggerations. She moved out soundly & well covering the ground in profile.

2nd – Goldberg's – Newlin Chalice At Molesend J.W – All quality. Slighlty longer cast than 1, but nicely put together front & rear angles. Firm in topline. Lots to like. She moved out very well in all directions with ease.

3rd – Jones's – Sabinhay Chutney At Clairdale.

Minor Puppy Bitch - 3, 0abs

1st - Craig's – Davricard Scilla – Really lovely puppy of high quality. Pleasing head & exp. Very nicely constructed throughout with no exaggerations giving her a balanced look standing & moving. Very sound fore & aft & excellent free ground covering profile movement. Considered for top awards very promising baby. **Best Puppy In Show.**

 2^{nd} – Hill's – Dapperdawg Miss Chief – Sweet pup lighter in substance than 1, whom she was unlucky to Meet on the day. She stood & showed well & moved out cleanly away & back & easily in profile movement.

3rd - Ravell's - Tungri Daydream.

Puppy Bitch - 7,1abs

1st – Finlay's – Rhiconich Holly, Liked this all quality girl very much but she needs to relax to showed herself of best. Very feminine head & lovely exp. & nice general appearance. She is good for size & substance, nicely put together throughout with a nice outline. Looked well standing and moved soundly with ease.

Junior Bitch - 8, 1abs

1st – Cuthill's Divinebrae Pop My Cork – Nice quality & typical in type. Fem. Head & lovely soft exp. Nice for size & substance. Balanced look with lots to like. She moved sound away & back & easily in profile.

2nd – Goldberg's – Molesend Query – Very appealing in appearance and similar remarks to 1, apply. Nice quality and of good make & shape throughout. Loved her head & exp. Moved out well in all directions.

3rd - Deans - Gempeni Ballet

Post Graduate Bitch - 9, 3abs

1st – Hartlands – Franjean Check Me Out At Fairleedale (Imp) – Loved this one for high quality. So feminine she can best be described as chocolate box pretty. Nice head & a lovely melting exp. Adequate fore angles & good rear angles. Cast a nice outline. She was very sound coming & going and covered the ground in profile with ease. Res. Best Bitch.

2nd – Fraser's – Wyvisview Harlequin – Lovely for size, type & quality, nice front angles & adequate rear Angulation. Nothing overdone about her giving a balanced outline. She too moved out soundly & well, lots to like, unlucky to meet 1.

Limit Bitch - 9, 2abs

1st – Calikes's – Newlin Mattie J.W & Sh CM – Loved this one for breed stamp & soundness. Lovely quality & type.

Pleasing head & exp. Free standing on the floor she cast a very nice outline. Nice fore & hind angulation. and so well put together throughout. She excelled in soundness in all directions and her profile movement was effortless. **Best Bitch & Res Best in Show.**

2nd – Goldberg's – Broadshore Vedette At Molesend – Another quality girl of very nice type. Lovely fem. head & soft exp. Nice for size & substance, very nice front & rear angles used to vantage on the move where she was sound fore & aft & free ground covering profile movement.

3rd – Deans – Gempeni Flower Girl J.W & ShCM.

Open Bitch - 5, 3abs

1st – Woodcock's – Roodwood Melody ShCM – Another of very nice breed type with a very balanced look. Nice size & substance, nice fore and hind agulation nothing exaggerated. Cast a very nice outline standing & moving where she was very sound with free easy profile movement, lots to like her, was very close up to principal winners.

2nd – Findlay's – Tannahill Odina at Rhiconich – Very Attractive & of lovely quality and type. Fem. Head & lovely soft exp. She is nicely made with a clean cut balanced look. Sound moving away & back & well in profile but could not match 1's, excellent side gait.
