Veteran Dog: (3)

1st – Cuthill's CH. SERENAKER TRAIL BY MAGIC, 12yrs old, good head with dark eye, and low set ears, slightly arched neck, good front assembly with deep chest, well sprung ribs, level back, good legs and feet, nice bend of stifle, good mover.

2nd – Watson & Fallon's NEWLIN ANCHOR CHIEF AW (S), 10yrs old, slightly taller than winner, liked his head, eye and ear placement, good length of neck, nice shoulder placement, level back, chest deep with good ribs carried back, good legs and feet, good quarters, moved well.

3rd – McGiffen's RHICONICH KIRK.

Puppy Dog: (3)

1st – Brown's BEAGLE BOYS MR FARENHEIGHT, well balanced youngster with good head, dark eye and low set ears, nicely arched neck, well placed shoulder, elbows tight, good legs and feet, deep chest with ribs sprung, back level, nicely muscled quarters, good mover, Res. Best Dog.

2nd – Findlay's RHICONICH RHYS, another nice youngster a bit bigger, would like a little more length to muzzle, dark eye and low set ears, good arched neck, good shoulder placement, chest well down with good ribs, level back, well muscled quarters, moved well.

3rd – Cuthill's DIVINEBRAE ALL FIRED UP

Junior Dog: (3, 1abs)

1st – Binks TANNAHILL KENT, liked his head, dark eye and low set ears, arched neck, shoulders well laid back, level back, chest deep, ribs well sprung, good legs and feet, nicely muscled quarters, moved well.

2nd – McAuley's FINMORLAN RUFUS, taller dog with good head, dark eye and ear placement, good front assembly with deep chest and level back, good legs and feet, nicely muscled quarters, moved bit close behind.

Graduate Dog: (4)

1st – Hill's DIVINEBRAE COMING SOON AT DAPPERDAWG, well balanced with a good head, dark eye and good ear placement, good length of neck and front assembly, elbows tight and well under, chest deep with well sprung ribs carried back, good legs and feet, back level, well muscled quarters, good mover, Best Dog & BOS.

2nd – Findlay's RHICONICH RHYS

3rd – Brown's MCKLEESUM BUDDY

Post Graduate Dog: (3)

1st – Snedden's FALLOWFIELD EVOLUTION AT HARDEXSPEN, nice head with dark eye and good ear placement, good length of neck, nice front assembly, level back, deep chest, good ribs, legs and feet, fair quarters, moved well.

2nd - Goldberg's NEWLIN PERTH AT MOLESEND, nice head, eye and ear placement, ample neck, would prefer more length and size.

3rd – English's GEMPENI PASO

Limit Dog: (4)

1st – Cuthill's DIVINBRAE PLAY THE GAME, liked his make and shape, good head with dark eye and low set ears, good length of neck, well laid shoulder, deep chest with well sprung ribs, good legs and feet, level back, nicely muscled quarters, needs to settle in front movement.

2nd – Findlay's FALLOWFIELD ADORED AT RHICONICH, nice dog just bit on big side for me, good head, dark eye and ear placement, arched neck, well laid shoulder, deep chest, level back, good ribs well sprung, muscled quarters, another that needs to settle in front movement.

3rd – English's GEMPENI PASO

Open Dog: (2, 1abs)

1st – Findlay's RHICONICH JARVIS, liked his head, eye and ear placement, good length of neck, well placed shoulder, elbows could be tighter, back level, chest deep with ribs well sprung, nicely muscled quarters, moved well.

Veteran Bitch: (5, 2abs)

1st – Deans IR. CH BARTERHOUND BOUQUET FOR GEMPENI JW, 11yrs, nicely balanced with a good head, eye and ear placement, good length of neck, well laid shoulder, level back, deep chest, good legs and feet, nicely muscled quarters, moved well, BVIS.

2nd – Hartland's NEWLIN INKSPOT AT FAIRLEEDAILE, 7yrs, another nice veteran with a good head, eye and ears, nice length of neck, fair front assembly, elbows could be tighter, chest deep, good ribs, and quarters, moved well.

3rd – Bennett's SERENAKER SOGNI D'ORO AT TACOMADREAM

Puppy Bitch: (4, 2abs)

1st – Goldberg's MOLESEND TEALEAF, baby pup with a good head, dark eye and low set ears, good length of neck, well placed shoulder, level back, deep chest with ribs well carried back, good legs and feet, good quarters with nice bend of stifle, moved well.

2nd – Foster & Jones STORMPASTURE OPERETTA, another baby with a good head, eye and ear placement, nicely arched neck, well placed shoulder, deep chest with good ribs, good legs and feet, nicely muscled quarters, just needs to settle in topline.

Junior Bitch: (6, 2abs)

1st – Foster & Jones STORMPASTURE NIGHTCAP, nicely balanced youngster with good head, eye and ear placement, arched neck, well placed shoulder, elbows well under, level back, deep chest with nicely sprung ribs, nicely muscled quarters, good mover, Res. BB & Res. BIS.

2nd – Goldberg's MOLESEND TRANQUIL, lovely balanced puppy, liked her head, dark eye and low set ears, nicely arched neck, good shoulder placement, deep chest, elbows well under, good ribs and carried back, well bodied, good legs and feet, nicely muscled quarters with well bent stifles, good mover, BPB.

3rd – Hill's SHERCROFT HECKLE VON DAPPERDAWG

Graduate Bitch: (5, 3abs)

1st – Hill's SHERCROFT HECKLE VON DAPPERDAWG, fair head, dark eye and ear placement, ample neck length, chest deep, level back, good legs and feet, nice quarters, moved okay.

2nd – MacDonalds FINMORLAN RUBY, nice bitch but a wee bit shy today, good head with dark eye and low set ears, arched neck, good shoulder placement, well bodied with deep chest, nice quarters, moved okay.

Post Graduate Bitch: (3, 1abs)

1st – Cuthill's DIVINBRAE POP NY CORK, nice bitch with a good head, dark eye and ear placement, arched neck, good front assembly, level back, deep chest with good ribs, good legs and feet, well muscled quarters, moved well but toes in slightly in front.

2nd – McGiffen's MISKEN FORTUNA AT LADYBROW, smaller made bitch, with a good head, eye and ears, ample neck, front assembly okay, level back, deep chest, nice quarters, moved fair.

Limit Bitch: (5, 2abs)

1st – Parkin's MOLESEND QUERY, liked her head, eye and ear placement, good length of neck, well placed shoulder, level back, deep chest with good ribs, good legs and feet, nicely muscled quarters, moved well.

2nd – Deans GEMPENI FLOWER GIRL, good head, eye and ear placement, arched neck, nice front assembly, level back, chest deep with ribs sprung, good legs and feet, nicely muscled quarters, moved well.

3rd – Bennett's TACOMADREAM DUCHESS

Open Bitch: (5, 1abs)

1st – Cuthill's DETRICK FIEFLY OVER DIVINBRAE, lovely balanced bitch, good head with a dark eye and low set ears, neck arched, well laid shoulder, elbows well tucked under, chest deep with well sprung ribs carried back, level back, good legs and feet, well muscled quarters, good mover, BB & BIS.

2nd – Findlay's RHICONICH FIONNUALA, liked her make and shape, good head, eye and ears, arched neck, good front assembly although elbows

could be tighter, level back, well bodied with well sprung ribs, nicely muscled quarters, moved well but needs to tighten in front.

3rd – Ravell's TUNGRI SHOOTING STAR

Brace: (4, 1abs)

1st – Deans Brace, a nice pair for size and colour that complemented each other, moved well.

2nd – MacDonalds Brace, another pair that moved well.

3rd – Bennett's Brace.
