Best in Show Ch Bayard Glory Bee Res BIS Ch Davricard Jacob Best Puppy in Show Molesend Dormouse Best Veteran Ch Shercroft Apollo

MPD 1. Kingswin Bug 'A' Lugs. Just 6 months. A well boned puppy with a good head and ears, good length of neck and nice fill in front. Well angulated front and rear and with a well set tail. Moved well in profile but needs time to firm in topline and rear.

PD 1. Tannahill Vagabond. Pleasing for type with a good outline and balanced angulation. Enough bone for his size, good front and feet and has a good topline and tail set. Strode out well in profile and shown in good coat and condition. Best Puppy Dog.

JD 1. Dufosee Isaac By Annavah. Tri with a lovely head and expression, good neck and topline. Was well angulated behind and moving quite well. Could be more positive in front. 2. Tannahill Ghost Pepper. A stronger boned youngster with a broader skull than I prefer however, he was balanced and had good legs and feet and a good topline and tail and he moved well with good drive behind.

GD 1. Newlin Rambler. Tan/W nice type. Has a good head with well set ears, good topline and tail set. Has good ribbing and strong loin and a good rear with low hocks. Would like a better neck and shoulder but he moved quite well.2. Gempeni Charlock. He has not the balance of construction of the winner but has good ribbing and topline. Movement was erratic and short striding but he had a delightful temperament.

PGD 1. Jalhar Fame N Fortune From Kelcardi. Has a well proportioned head with good ears, dark eye but lower rim could be tighter, good bone and a moderate front. Has a good spring of rib, strong loin and moderate rear angulation with good width of thigh. A nice free mover. 2. *Gempeni Charlock*

LD 1. Fallowfield Vincent. A very pleasing type who was compact and well proportioned with a good head, soft expression, fine ears which were well set and a good big nose. Has a good neck and shoulder and well sprung ribs. Liked his rear angles with good width of thigh which was lacking in quite a few today. Moved well in profile showing good drive behind. 2. Wyvisview Pinocchio. Tri with a pleasing head and expression good topline and tail set. Front a bit wide at elbow and has not the layback of shoulder of winner. Moved OK. 3. Gempeni Paso.

OD 1. Ch. Davricard Jacob. An outstanding dog for type and balance. Has a lovely head, a body of excellent proportions with a good topline and tail set. He is well balanced with good round bone and tight feet. His ribs are well sprung and he has a short loin and well let down hocks. He excelled on the move showing both reach and drive. Pleased to award him the CC.and Res. BIS and Best Opposite sex. 2. Ch Serenaker Armani. Also an impressive dog of good size and correct proportions who has a beautiful head and expression and an excellent outline which he held on the move. Had not quite the easy action and extension on the move as one today but a very worthy Ch who pressed the winner hard. Shown in excellent coat and condition. Res. CC 3. Deaconfield Kingcraft.

VD 1. Ch Shercroft Apollo JW SHCM Tan/wh of very nice type with good bone, is well ribbed and a really sound and true mover. Has a happy temperament and went well today. Best Veteran in Show.

MPB 1. Kingswin Looks Like Trouble. Litter sister to the MPD and much the same remarks apply to her. Has a lovely head, eyes and ears, good bone, nice reach of neck, good top and underlines. She is well ribbed and compact and she moved really well for her age. Just needs time to firm up all round. 2. Felinoak El Koko Loko. Taller bitch with nice head and good bone and feet. Ok in neck and shoulders and with a good topline and bend of stifle. Move well in profile but close behind at the moment. 3. Dughallmor Kiss The Bride.

PB 1. Molesend Dormouse. Tan/wh of very nice type with a lovely feminine head. Has a good front of moderate width with straight legs, good feet and neat elbows. She has a good neck and shoulders, good top and underlines, is well ribbed back, short in couplings and with a well balanced rear and low hocks. She moved really well and fully deserved Best Puppy In Breed. 2. Keltycreed Danger Digits. A smaller Tri, proportionate for her size who looked very nice in profile. Has a good topline and tail and moved soundly

front and rear. A bit narrow all through at the moment and needs time to mature. In excellent coat and condition. 3. *Dughallmor Kiss The Bride*

JB Two lovely bitches headed this class. 1. Davricard Marcia. Very nice for type with a good head with dark eye and good nose. She is well boned with excellent feet, has a good deep body, well sprung ribs and compact loin. Liked her rear with good width of thigh and has a good tail. Moved well in profile but could have been a shade more positive in front today.2. Annavah Princess Tiana. Very feminine and of lovely type. Has a beautiful head with appealing expression and good bone for her size. Has a good neck and shoulders, strong topline and a balanced rear. A bit narrower in front and closer in movement than winner at present but a very promising prospect. 3. Wyvisview KnickerBocker.

NB 1. Braveair Rum and Ginger. Liked her type and overall proportions, good bone, ribs and compact loin. She has a lovely head and expression with a good nose and ears. She was shown in excellent muscular condition and was moving really well both front and rear. 2. Molesend Freesia. A confident tri baby with a beautiful head and expression, good straight legs and tight feet and moving quite well. Nicely proportioned and just needs time to grow up.

GB 1. Dufosee Iyla at Bondlea. A very nice tri with a beautiful head with dark eyes and good ears. Has a good front with straight well boned legs and good feet. Has a good neck and shoulder, good ribs and compact loin and rear angles to balance her front. She moved very well and was shown in good coat and condition. 2. Molesend Crumble. A very attractive Tan/wh with a good head and expression,good ears and nose. Has good ribbing and a good underline and her front and rear angles were balanced. Strode out well in profile just preferred the winner coming towards. 3. Butterow Token

PGB 1. Tannahill Ruby. Nice type and has a good outline and profile movement. Liked her head with soft expression, good ears and nose. Has a good neck, topline and tail, a good depth of chest and well angulated rear. 2. Annavah Star Above Madika. The more mature of these bitches who also has a very nice head with dark eye and excellent pigment. Has a good depth of chest and is well ribbed. Has a well muscled rear and good topline. Also moved well in profile and it was a close decision between these two. 3. *Butterow Token* LB 1. Gempeni Cornflower. Really lovely bitch with a good head and ears and excellent pigmentation. Has a good neck and well laid shoulders, good legs and feet, neat elbows and was well ribbed and compact in loin. Her rear balanced her front and her hocks well let down. A very nice free mover. 2. Bondlea Lucy JW Another who appealed greatly for her good breed type. Has a lovely head , good neck and shoulder, good round bone and good top and underlines. She is well angulated both ends and moved very well. 3. Butterow Rumba.

OB 1. Ch Bayard Glory Bee. A beautiful bitch so balanced and sound in all departments. She is feminine and has a lovely head and expression, a well filled front, excellent neck leading smoothly into well laid shoulders, giving good top and underlines and is an exceptionally good mover. Shown in good muscular condition I was pleased to award her the CC followed by BOB and BIS over an equally impressive dog who couldn't quite match her in front movement today. 2. Ch Serenaker Maid in America. Another beautifully constructed bitch who excels in type and movement. She has a lovely head, good outline and was shown in good muscle and condition. Bitch Res CC. 3. Annavah Lady Gaga

VB 1. Madika Spot On JW SHCM one I have judged and admired previously. Now a veteran of 8 years and still a force to be reckoned with. She has a lovely head, is well constructed with good top and underlines, was well muscled and moved freely with good reach and drive. Best VB. 2. Bayard Make Believe. An 11 year old of good type and in excellent condition for her age. A very true mover and showed so well. 3. Detrick Firefly Over Divinebrae.
